CKMS Band November 2018 Oahu Trip Student Behavior Expectations

- 1. All students attending the trip are expected to follow all CKMS rules and Department of Education Chapter 19 rules while on the trip including and especially:
 - a. No consumption of alcohol, smoking, or drugs. No possession of any items that are or are related to alcohol, smoking, or drugs.
 - b. No weapons or objects that could be considered dangerous as according to the Hawaii Department of Education.
- 2. Students are to listen to all adult instructions, including those of chaperones, Seawind Tours Staff, and any other adult in authority. Remember, you are representing not only the CKMS Band but also all of Kauai at these events. We want to leave a good impression.
- 3. Students are expected to sleep in their assigned room and ride on their assigned bus. No changes will be allowed without permission of the band director.
- 4. Public Display of Affection will not be allowed at anytime during the trip. Students will be given only one warning about this. If a second warning is given, formal disciplinary action will be taken.
- 5. No girls will be allowed in boys' rooms and no boys shall be allowed in girls' rooms at anytime. A student will automatically be sent home if this rule is broken.
- 6. Students are expected to stay with the band at all times are not allowed to wander on their own. When students have free time they are expected to remain in groups of at least three. This is to ensure that all students remain safe throughout the trip.
- 7. There are two deadlines for the evenings:
 - a. All students in rooms-all students must be in their assigned room getting ready for bed. Students may not leave their rooms once this time starts until morning when they are awoken by a chaperone.
 - b. Lights Out-Students should be in bed, the chaperones will check to make sure all lights are out and all students are in bed. We will have long full days so sleep is necessary and important.
 - c. Any student found outside of their room, except in the case of extreme emergencies, will automatically be sent home. Students are not allowed to leave the hotel alone.
- 8. Students are responsible for their own belongings and valuables. If they do not feel comfortable holding on to their spending money, they may individually work out something with their chaperone. Do not bring iPods, iPads, cameras, or cell phones if you are not willing to take the risk of it getting lost or stolen. The CKMS Band and CKMS will not be responsible for anything that is lost or stolen. If you decide to bring an iPod or other music-making device, headphones are required to use them. Please turn off these objects when instructed.
- 9. Students will be allowed to bring cell phones for safety purposes. Every student who is bringing a phone must notify the chaperones and band director and they must give them that number. Phones will be collected at night and charged by the chaperones; students will not be allowed to hold on to them during lights out. The phone should only be on during free time and cell phones will be confiscated immediately if used inappropriately and kept by the band director for the remainder of the trip, especially in the following situations:

- a. A student is found texting or talking on the phone while we are in a clinic, performance, or presentation.
- b. The student's phone rings or makes sound (even vibrating can be heard) during a situation that is inappropriate.
- 10. Students are the leave the busses, hotel room, and places we visit in better condition than when we arrived. Any damages or charges to hotel rooms will be split between each of the students staying in that room and charged directly to the parents of those students, including long distance phone calls and eating or drinking anything that can be charged.
- 11. Students are expected to wear the following attired for each day as stated below:
 - a. Uniform for Saturday
 - i. CKMS Band Polo Shirt, Black Shoes, Black Socks, Black Pants
 - b. Uniform for Sunday
 - i. CKMS Uniform Shirt and pants/shorts of choice
 - c. Uniform for Monday
 - i. CKMS Band T-Shirt and pants/shorts of choice
 - d. Uniform for Tuesday
 - i. CKMS Uniform Shirt and pants/shorts of choice.
- 12. There will be no swimming and trip participants will not be allowed near the water or the hotel pool at any time.
- 13. Sportsmanship
 - a. We are attending all of these events and clinics to become better musicians and performers. We are not competing with other bands or other schools. It is expected that all students try their best and they clap and congratulate the other bands at performances. When complimented, say "thank you."

ALL STUDENTS MAY BE SENT HOME, AT THE EXPENSE OF THEIR PARENTS, IF FOUND TO BE BREAKING ANY OF THE RULES AS STATED ABOVE. THIS STUDENTS WILL BE ESCORTED BACK TO KAUAI BY A TEACHER OR CHAPERONE AND HIS OR HER PARENTS/GUARDIANS WILL PAY FOR THEIR FLIGHT BACK TO KAUAI, FOR THE ROUND TRIP FLIGHT OF THE CHAPERONE WHO MUST ACCOMPANY THAT STUDENT BACK TO KAUAI, AND ANY ADDITIONAL CHARGES OR FEES THAT MAY OCCUR.
