Grading: All events are mandatory. If a student participates in all, he or she will automatically receive an A for the performance portion of his or her grade. Please note on the permission form if your child is not allowed to participate in a certain event. If a student cannot make a performance, he or she must make it up in a solo test performance. This test will be graded based on accuracy, and students will not automatically receive an A.

Transportation: Students and parents are responsible for finding transportation to and from CKMS. For safety reasons, students must leave with an adult and will not be allowed to go off on their own. *If finding a ride is a problem, Ms. Tochiki is willing to help find rides for students who may not have one. Please let her know ASAP.* Students cannot go directly home from the parade; they must come back to Chiefess.
